

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLSONVILLE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF EXPLOSIVES; PROVIDING A PENALTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2000 FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF.

WHEREAS, by proclamation issued of [date of disaster declaration], the Mayor declared a state of disaster for The City of Olsonville resulting from

WHEREAS, said state of disaster requires that certain emergency measures to be taken; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLSONVILLE, TEXAS

Section 1. The following regulations shall take effect immediately upon issuance and shall remain in effect until the state of disaster is terminated:

Section 2: A person shall not sell, barter, loan, or give away arms, ammunition, dynamite, or other explosives in the following area(s):

Any person who shall intentionally, knowingly, recklessly, or with criminal negligence, violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$2000. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
