A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL _____ OF THE CITY OF OLSONVILLE, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON _____ 20 IN RESPONSE TO _____

WHEREAS, on _____, Mayor of the City of Olsonville, Texas, issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Olsonville, in response to the anticipated loss of life and damage to property threatened by conditions resulting from Hurricane _____, and

WHEREAS, the City of Olsonville on the _____ day of _____ 20____, suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from Hurricane _____; and

_____ WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLSONVILLE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The declaration of disaster, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on _____, 20____, shall be renewed and continued through _____ 20____, in accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.
